- ♥ Treat everyone with dignity and respect
- ♥ Treat everyone equally
- ♥ Set an example you wish others to follow
- ♥ Do not judge
- ♥ Always tell the truth, it is human to make mistakes
- ♥ Help us create a welcoming and inclusive environment
- ♥ Speak and act in a way that makes everyone feel safe
- ♥ Alert a member of staff or a volunteer if you have any concerns

Please do not...

- ♥ Use abusive, aggressive, or bullying language or behaviour
- ♥ Discriminate against anyone for any reason
- ♥ Do anything that makes others feel unsafe or uncomfortable
- ♥ Disrupt the sessions in a way that negatively impacts others

Anyone who does not follow these rules of conduct will be asked to leave the premises.
